When can your property be searched? When school officials have "reasonable suspicion" that you're breaking school rules or are engaging in criminal activities.

Do teachers have the right to search your phone because it's confiscated? According to the 4th Amendment, not without a proper warrant, or in some emergency.

Can they ask for your social media account passwords? Not generally, but Illinois law allows school administrators to demand passwords if a student is suspected of breaking school rules.

Is it constitutional to allow random drug sniff searches by dogs? Yes, because it's not considered an actual search.
